Sentence fragments are usually pieces of sentences that have been cut, separated, or disconnected from the main clause. To correct sentence fragments, you may need to add punctuation marks, add or remove words, or the original sentence or fragment may need to be rewritten completely. The following examples first show a fragment and then a way to change the fragment in an entire sentence. Snippet: The shop offers many types of ice cream. Vanilla, chocolate, strawberry and mint. Complete: The shop offers many types of ice cream, such as vanilla, chocolate, strawberry and mint. If you look at the fragment, the first sentence about the store is a complete sentence. It has a theme (the store) and the verb (offers). However, the fragment comes after the period. Vanilla, chocolate, strawberry and mint is not a complete thought. If you read it out loud, you can say it doesn't make sense on its own. It has no verb or subject. It's just not a complete thought. To correct the fragment, we can add it to the first sentence. Instead of a period, you can add a comma, and you must add the conjunctive words to make it a complete thought. Read the full sentence aloud. When you read it out loud, you can hear it makes sense now. Some sentence fragments might be harder to find out. A subject or verb, which are the key components of a complete sentence, might be missing. See example below. Fragment: Dogs of all kindsLeer this phrase aloud. It's not complete. What do dogs do? Are dogs the main theme of this phrase? Is it a complete thought? We don't have a verb, and the guy may not even be the dogs. This fragment might undergo several types of revision. Completed #1 : Dogs of all kinds were running around the dog park this afternoon. Completed #1 : They found dogs of all kinds when they went to the shelter to adopt a dog. The following example is an example of a fragment missing a subject/main name: Fragment: hired Sam to paint a mural on the brick wall of the library. Who hired Sam? Many times, fragments simply won't sound right to native English speakers. The fragments will make no sense and will sound like a baby or caveman speaking in incomplete sentences, or simply like nonsense. Make sure the fragments become complete thoughts that communicate through complete sentences.
